

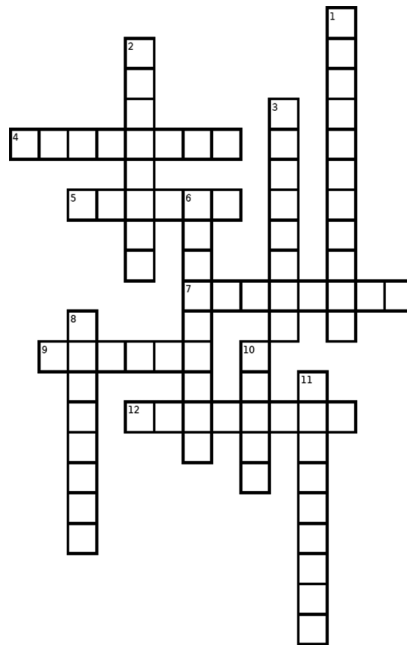

- 1. Syndrome characterised by white forelock, broad nasal root, heterochromia iridum and congenital deafness
- 2. Elfin facies syndrome
- 3. Patau syndrome occurs due to Trisomy ____
- 6. Also known as 'oculo-auriculo-vertebral dysplasia' with hemifacial microsomia
- 8. A syndrome resulting from a DNA repair defect, leading to increased sensitivity to the lethal effects of UV light
- 10. This syndrome has Congenital Hemidysplasia with Ichthyosiform erythroderma and Limb Defects
- 11. A disorder of peroxisomal dysfunction characterised with hypotonia and dysmorphic features at birth

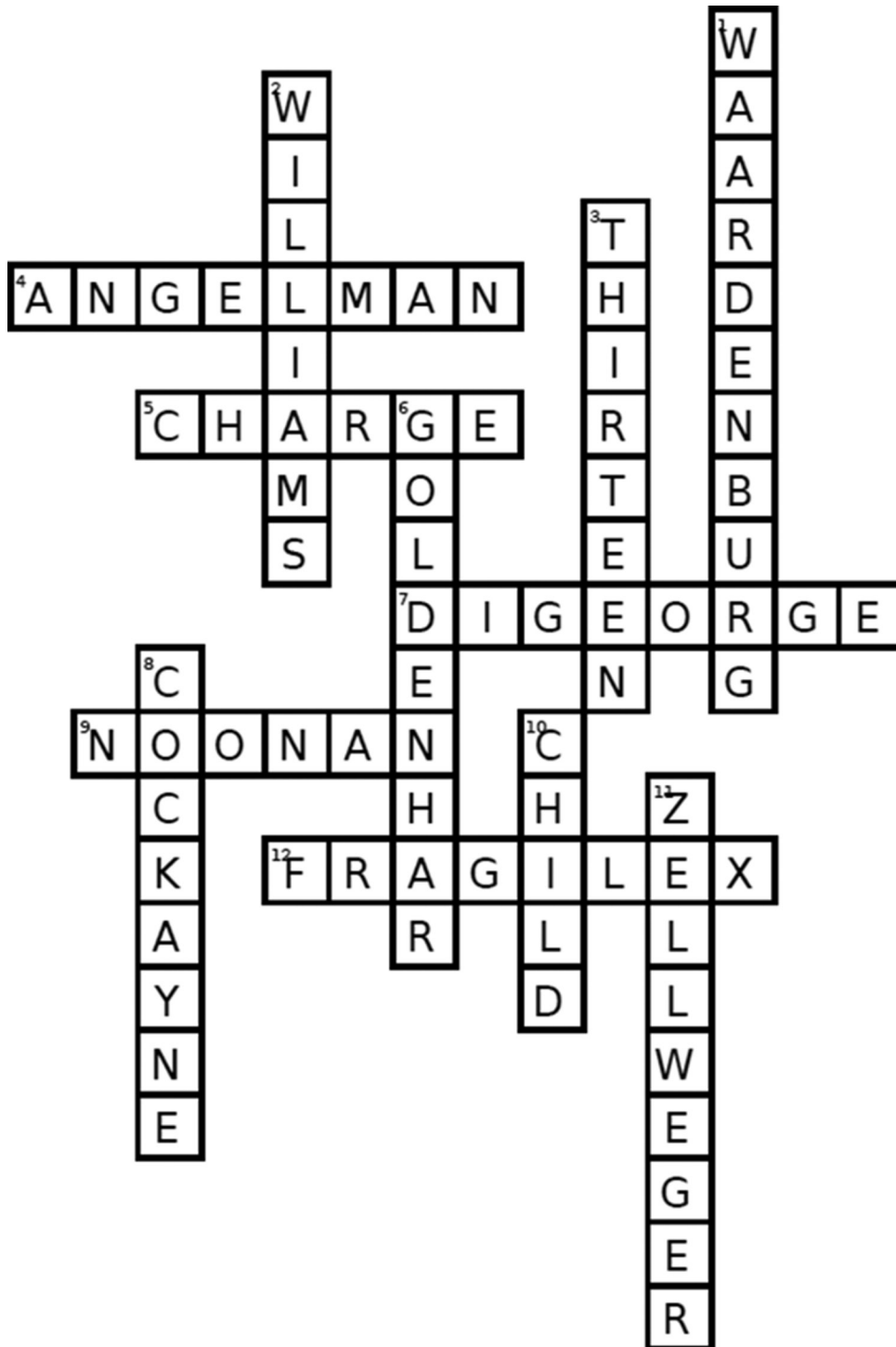
- 4. This syndrome is caused due to a deletion of segment 15q11-q13 on the maternally derived chromosome 15

Down syndrome

1. Down syndrome is named after John Langdon Down, who was the first to categorize the common features of people with the condition.
2. Dr. Jerome Lejeune discovered that Down syndrome is a genetic disorder whereby a person has three copies of chromosome 21 instead of two.

Hall's criteria for diagnosing Down syndrome

1. Flat face
2. Upslanted palpebral fissure
3. Small dysplastic ear
4. Short neck with redundant skin

5. Hypotonia
6. Poor Moro reflex
7. Hyperflexible joints
8. Simian crease
9. Short fifth finger with clinodactyly
10. Pelvic dysplasia

“Syndromes without a name” (SWAN)

- The SWAN is a term used when children have symptoms of genetic conditions but cannot yet be diagnosed.
