Deadlines

- a. Abstract submission 15th June 2025
- b. Final Free Paper in full 15th July 2025
- c. Final Poster 15th August 2025

Step 1: Submission of Abstract - Guidelines

Eligibility - All presenting authors must be registered for NASCON 2025

- Open to all Post Graduates / Senior Residents / Fellows / Faculty / Specialists
- Only original research articles that haven't been published or presented already will be considered.

Relevance - All work should be related to Neonatal Anesthesia /Critical Care/Newborns /Neonates

Word Limit - 250 words, excluding Title / References.

Format-Graphs/tables/images should not be included in the abstract.

- Abstracts stating "data will be discussed in the presentation" will not be accepted.
- Language, Font size: Abstract must be submitted and presented in English, MS Word Times New Roman Font, 12-point with single line spacing, and the title in bold face.

Authors

- Include a maximum of 4 names (including presenting author).
- Presenter details to be provided: Name, qualification, designation, name of institution, phone number, email address (all communications will be via email).
- Best 3 papers will be selected for presentation on 7 Sept 2025.

Abstract Structure

Page 1: Details of the presenter along with Conference Registration proof

Page 2: Undertaking - That work is original, not already published, and NOC from co-authors

Page 3: for original work

- a. Introduction / Aims / Objectives: State the main objective of the study
- b. Methodology: Briefly describe the design of the study and how it was conducted
- c. Statistical analysis, method used
- d. Relevant results
- e. Conclusion: To be precise and concise
- f. References (4-8)

Headings for a Case Report - Introduction, case details, discussion, conclusion, references (4-6)

- Last date for abstract submission: 15th June 2025
- Full paper to be submitted by 15th July 2025 (Guidelines will be shared after 15th June 2025).
